Sitar Recital by Dr. Debojyoti Chakraborty

Dr. Debojyoti Chakraborty, is a Senior Principal Scientist at CSIR-IGIB, New Delhi, a recipient of multiple national and international young scientist awards and has been trained in sitar for over 30 years under two maestros, Late Pt. Sunil Saha and Pt. Debaprasad Chakraborty. He has performed widely in India and Europe and has won the best instrumentalist award at several platforms including the Dover Lane Music Conference Competition and the West Bengal State Music Academy among others. A recipient of the national scholarship in music from Ministry of Human Resources, he has performed and contributed to academic research on the mathematical modelling of Indian classical music and has been featured in print and broadcast media in India and abroad.

Shri. Subhajyoti Guha, holds a Masters degree in applied Mathematics, is a senior disciple of Pandit Sankha Chatterjee, a much sought after Tabla player from Kolkata. Subhajyoti tours regularly in India, USA, Canada, Europe and performs with many senior and famous artistes of India. Subhajyoti has also extended his horizons outside Indian Classical Music and collaborated with many jazz musicians from USA and Canada. He has formed his own Raga Fusion Band named "Aavartan Ensemble" in Kolkata. Subhajyoti is also very successful as a Guru and has students in Canada, USA and China, plus his own institution in Kolkata, named "Aavartan School of Rhythm".
